LICENCE CONDITIONS

1. This licence only permits the business to carry on and provide the services of individual operator licence holders for the activities of: Crowd Controller and Security Guard.
2. This licence only permits the licence holder to provide the services of security guards, being Unarmed Guard, as the licence does not authorise the provision of any other aspect of security guard work being Armed Guard, Control Room Operator, Monitoring Centre Operator, Cash-In-Transit and Guard with a dog.
3. The licence holder must not permit any employee to carry or use security equipment, being a baton and/or handcuffs, unless the employee has the approval of the licence holder and the employee has undertaken training relevant to that security equipment from an approved security training organisation.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. It is an offence to breach any of the conditions of this licence.
2. This licence does not entitle the Nominated Person or its employee to possess, carry or use a firearm for security purposes unless they are the holder of a firearms licence for those purposes under the Firearms Act 1996.
3. It is an offence to fail to notify the Licensing & Regulation Division in writing within 7 days of a change of address to which all communications and notices may be addressed.
4. If the licence is lost, stolen or destroyed you must apply in writing for a duplicate licence which will incur a fee.
5. If you wish to renew this licence you must lodge with the Licensing & Regulation Division, prior to the date of expiry, an application for renewal. If no application is received prior to the date of expiry, the licence is deemed to have expired and a new application will be required to be lodged.

7. Legislation relevant to security licensing is the Private Security Act 2004 and Private Security Regulations 2016.
